2019 REPORT FROM COVENANT HIGH SCHOOL

2018-2019 Highlights

- The school was blessed with an enrollment of 103 students for the 2018-2019 school year.
- The school was successfully reaccredited by the ACSI. The following accommodations were awarded by the committee:
 - The school board is deeply committed to offering Christian education that is mission centered and based on the founding documents.
 - The school board facilitated a smooth transition in leadership.
 - The curriculum has a well-documented biblical foundation
 - School personnel demonstrate strong commitment to the school mission.
 - The school demonstrates excellence at creating a Christ-like culture of respect, caring, and compassion for others.
- Out of thirty-six possible winners in the Pierce County Library's Writing and Art Contest, six Covenant High School students placed in the categories of poetry, short story, and drawing. Julia Fisher placed first in poetry for her poem *Eternal Summer*.
- Mary Boyde Funches, Honor Tamminga, and Christina Sullivan scored in the top 3% of all students taking the CLT-10, Classic Learning Test. The Classic Learning Test is a new alternative to the SAT and is accepted by over 150 Christian colleges across the nation.
- The school purchased a new school bus, upgraded room 304 with an 80" flat screen TV, and purchased new laptops for four faculty members.
- Covenant High School will host their first ever debate tournament on March 13 and 14 for the National Christian Forensics and Communications Association. All church congregants are welcome to attend and invited to serve as volunteer judges.
- All congregants are invited to attend the Covenant High School silent auction on May 2nd. This new exciting event will be offsite at the Tacoma Armory and will support the scholarship fund and science department.
