

Covenant High School Report 2021-2022

- Covenant High School partnered with Covenant College to host a Christian Worldview Conference for teachers. The conference had 47 attendees from a variety of schools in the south sound. Faculty received education training from Covenant College President Dr. J. Derek Halvorson, Dr. Stephen Kaufmann, and Dr. Jack E. Beckman.
- After the loss of the overnight field trip in fall 2020, Covenant journeyed to Lakeview Christian Camp in Auburn and visited the historic railway museum in Snoqualmie, while also hiking Twin Falls trail.
- The first UK Historical Tour since 2018 was completed. The trip was led by Dick Hannula, who was accompanied by faculty chaperones Wendy Tamminga and Principal David Miller.
- Senior Jeremy Douglass was named as a commended student by the National Merit Scholarship Program. This award is given to the top 4% of scorers on the PSAT.
- Covenant High School officially joined the WIAA, and 15 students competed in cross country. The girls team qualified for the state meet.
- The school's second online silent auction successfully raised \$47,606. These contributions funded our scholarship fund, a new cross-country tent, and the renovation of room 105/106 into the Exordium. The Exordium is a designated, comfortable space for college advising and academic support.
- Newly adopted preview days in October created excitement and enthusiasm for the incoming freshman class.
- We welcomed Pedro Moura as our science teacher. Pedro was connected to CHS through the Discovery Institute and is sponsored by the school on an H1B visa.
