

## Questions for Kids

Drawn from “The Prophet,” A Sermon on Deuteronomy 18:9-22

1. What is a prophet? Why did God give prophets to Israel?
2. Are there still prophets for the church today? Why or why not?
3. In the sermon, Pastor said that God designed us to be listeners. What does this mean? How could you prove that this is true?
4. In the sermon, Pastor Steven talked about how the world often tells us not to listen to God, to authorities, or to others. Can you think of some examples of this?
5. What bad things will happen if we don't listen to God, our parents, or wise people and instead try to listen ONLY to our own hearts?
6. In John 10:27, Jesus said, “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.” Ask a parent to look up and show the following video, which shows us how sheep know the voice of their shepherd (*the video is less than 2 minutes long*). <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sIn2CnTUCb0>. **My Sheep Hear My Voice [AMAZING TEST ]- John 10:27 (Bible Truth Proven )**
7. What can we learn from these sheep?
8. If Jesus is in heaven, then how do we hear His voice?
9. What makes it hard for you to listen to God? To your parents? To teachers and other authority figures? To your siblings?

10. In the sermon, Pastor Steven talked about “dangerous and attractive voices.” Can you think of examples of characters from movies, books, stories, or the Bible who have “dangerous and attractive voices?”
  
11. In your life, which voice do you need to ignore or run away from?
  
12. How can your family encourage you to listen better to God and wise people?
