1. This week’s sermon and text were about our future in the eternal state. As you look forward to this, what are some of the things you are most excited about? What anxieties or questions do you have about it?
2. In verse 26 Jesus quotes Exodus 3:6. As a group, flip to that reference and talk about how Jesus derives the doctrine of The Resurrection of the Dead from this verse. (In other words, what is the thought process that moves from Exodus 3:6 to the doctrine of the Resurrection?) More broadly, how does Jesus’ approach to exegesis compare to ours? What can we learn from the way Jesus exegetes the Torah?
3. Look again at verse 25. In what sense(s) will we be “like the angels” in The Resurrection? In what sense(s) will we not be “like the angels?”
